The owner/designer Piotr says that this story begins with an original 80 years old wooden floor and it continues with revitalized gems from the 40' & 60'.

This story begins with an 80 years old wooden floor originating from the tenement house, and it continues with revitalised gems from the 1940s: lacquered cabinets in the bedroom and the kitchen, the Mart Stam's chair and a swivel chair from Sedus. The 1960s design representation includes, but is not limited to the Mussel transparent fibreglass armchair, Midgard medical lamps, and a custom-made side table. The apartment is spiked with early 21st century jewels such as Appendiabiti coat hanger designed by Carlo Contin for Cappellini. The interior was designed by Smallna Design Studio run by Piotr Płoski, who inherited this apartment from his grandmother. Vintage pieces come from smallna vintage gallery.
